If this home education plan is approved, the school department will expect to review an annual evaluation of the child's progress and may set guidelines and standards for this purpose to insure the evaluation of reasonable educational progress.
8. Response by School Authorities: Parents will receive a written response within fifteen (15) business days after receipt of completed home school application.
