Dear Students, Parents, and Employees:

Chapter 622 of the General Laws of Massachusetts, Acts of 1971 and Title IX Education Amendments of 1972 on the Federal level indicate:

"No person shall be excluded from or discriminated against in admission to a public school of any town, or in obtaining the advantages, privileges, and courses of study of such public school on account of race, color, sex, religion, national origin or sexual orientation."

Title IX is that portion of the Education Amendments of 1972 which forbids discrimination on the basis of sex in educational programs or activities which receive federal funds. These laws make it clear that all aspects of public school education must be fully open and available to members of both sexes. No school may exclude a child from any course, activity, service or resources available in that public school, on account of race, color, sex, religion, national origin or sexual orientation of such child.

These regulations address six (6) areas of school policy:

- *School Admissions
- *Admissions of Courses of Study
- *Guidance
- *Extra-curricular and Athletic Activities
- *Course Content
- *Scholarship and Monetary Award
