RIVER VALLEY DAY CAMP COVID-19 INFORMATION

At River Valley Day Camp, we follow the lowest risk and best practices protocols from the CDC's guidelines, and Massachusetts Minimum Requirements for Child Care and Youth Serving Programs (Office of EEC), with ongoing licensing inspections by the Deerfield Boards of Health. Our priority, as always, is to ensure that everyone has a healthy and safe camp experience. We will be working with the BOH, the CDC and EEC to prepare policies and procedures to guide us through this process.

As we face the reality that there may be restrictions, we are preparing a plan for social distancing, cohorts, face coverings, handwashing, and advanced cleaning and disinfecting protocols. We will also have much of our day outdoors and windows open indoors for better airflow. We will continue to watch these developments to see if/where we will need to make any adjustments as our program draws near.

We will provide you with updates as conditions change and new information becomes available that may affect the 2021 summer camp season. In addition, you will be informed well in advance of your time at camp, of any pre-camp requirements, changes to the schedule, and safety protocols that will be in effect during your time at camp.

We all aspire to gain part of our "normal" life back. In addition, a safe, social atmosphere will be essential in helping some children find their footage again. Summer camp will matter more now than ever, because it provides children with structured, extracurricular activities where they are engaged with friends and have social and emotional support.

Should the pandemic force us to cancel our 2021 program, refunds will be given in full.

Early and Late care will not be available this summer and we are unsure about field trips or swimming regulations at this time.

Registration will now be open. Space may be limited this season, so sign up soon!
